BILLY BOB PRODUCTIONS PRESENTS A TOMMY YOUNGSTEEN TRIBUTE TO TOM PETTY & THE HEARTBREAKERS FRIDAY FEBRUARY 9 at TURBO HAUS in ST. HENRI.

Tommy Youngsteen, a Canadian tribute band fronted by ex-Stars guitarist Alan Snoddy and anchored by the drumming of Josh Trager of Sam Roberts Band, will return to Montreal on Friday night February 9th at 9 PM (Doors at 8) to pay tribute to one of their musical heroes Tom Petty, who passed away suddenly last October, 18 days shy of his 67th birthday.



As the name suggests Tommy Youngsteen was formed as a side project tribute to Petty, Neil Young and Bruce Springsteen. Last April nearly 400 people partied at Fairmount Theatre to their Born in the USA tribute. What had been planned as a Pre-Christmas follow up to The Boss took a turn when Petty died of cardiac arrest, just one week after completing a 40th Anniversary Tour with The Heartbreakers.

Leaning on his numerous contacts in the music business, Snoddy has had as many as 11 fellow musicians on stage during his tribute shows which have drawn sold out crowds to venues across the country including Toronto's legendary Horseshoe Tavern. Snoddy and Trager will be joined on stage at Turbo Haus by guitarist Greg Paquet (The Stills), Del Cowsill of the famed Cowsills on bass and Jeff Heisholt (The Trews and Terra Lightfoot) on keyboards.

It's a rare opportunity to see these musicians in the cool, intimate setting of Turbo Haus, capacity 150. The Bad Starters will open.
